



APPLICATION FOR MINNESOTA METH WATCH GRANT

The Minnesota Meth Watch program, with support from Consumer Healthcare Products Association (CHPA), will award grants to Minnesota communities to help support local Meth Watch programs. Programs should be aimed toward: Reducing meth use through partnering with local law enforcement, business entities, elected officials and state agencies; Educating community retailers and their employees with the Meth Watch materials on how to identify meth users and related suspicious activity throughout the state; Improving lines of communication between retailers, law enforcement and community members; Training retailers and their employees to identify products being used in meth production to reduce theft of precursor materials; Increasing apprehension and reducing crime through the use of educational materials, community awareness and hotlines.

Preference will be given to programs that emphasize community education/awareness. Number of grants to be disbursed is dependent on number of applications and grant fund availability.

Grant Guidelines:

1. Submit a completed application postmarked by April 22, 2005 (maximum of 2 pages).
2. Grant money must be used in direct relation to meth awareness.
3. Recipients must submit a final report documenting program completion and outcome.
4. Recipients agree to promotion and documentation of their program by Minnesota Meth Watch.

Applications must include the following information:

1. Name and contact information for organization.
2. Name and contact information for contact person.
3. Name of county program will be held in.
4. Requested grant amount.
5. Will you be utilizing additional funding? Explain.
6. What is the proposed timeline of your program?
7. Who will be the attendees of your program?
8. Explain your program in detail to include goals and action plans.
9. Explain how the grant money will be used to facilitate your program.
10. Any additional information that you believe would be helpful to the grant review committee.
